

## GRAB GATHER GROW

Right, Wrong, and Holy

Grab this study, gather a few people, and grow in faith

### SCRIPTURE

(read over the scripture together)

Luke 10:36-37

<sup>36</sup>Which of these three, do you think, was a neighbour to the man who fell into the hands of the robbers?' <sup>37</sup>He said, 'The one who showed him mercy.'  
Jesus said to him, 'Go and do likewise.'

### OPENING PRAYER

Holy Spirit, you lead us into all truth and convict us of sin. Help us learn to better discern right from wrong and to understand that ethics as a follower of Christ involves mature reflection and complex decisions. Guide us in how we think, feel, and act, and that in all we do we bring honor to you. Instill in us strong faith and deep wisdom, that we might always know and do what is pleasing in your sight. In Jesus' name. Amen.

### DISCUSSION (one or two or ...)

Luke 6:27b says "*Go and do likewise.*" Does Jesus really mean it? Are we to go and love our hurting neighbors, not counting the cost or the danger and just go do it?

In an episode of the Spider-Man comic, a voice tells Peter Parker, "with great power there must also come—great responsibility." What is the relationship between power and status and the responsibility to do what is right?

How does your faith inform your understanding of right and wrong? What ethical and moral complexities have led you to think more carefully or deeply about your faith?

In an Heroic moment, Peter Parker, the altar ego of Spider-Man, comes fast to face with Sandman, the man who actually killed Peter's Uncle Ben. Setting aside his anger and vengeful rage, Peter listens to Sandman's story and chooses to forgive him. Sandman is sorrowful and apologetic as he turns to dust and flies away. How hard is forgiveness in your life?

Discuss the following quote ... "I said to the Lord, I'm going to hold steady on to you, and I know you will see me through." - Harriet Tubman.
