

YOUTH MISSIONS - 7/7

Our Youth are planning a mission trip for the summer of 2020. Change collected will provide scholarships to those who can't pay the full amount of the trip in addition to expenses incurred/supplies for the trip.

AVENUES FOR HOMELESS YOUTH - 7/14-7/28

For 25 years, Avenues has supported youth ages 16-24 in Hennepin County. Whether a young person needs someplace to stay for just one night, or a year and a half, Avenues empowers youth to find their path out of homelessness. We do that by providing a stable home, building trusting relationships, and navigating the youth's education, career, health and wellness and housing goals.

Avenues work is guided by the <u>9</u>
<u>Evidence-based, Guiding Principles to</u>
<u>Help Youth Overcome Homeless</u>
and our core values: equity, community, respect and dignity, trust, liberation and anti-oppression.



Starting soon Brooklyn UMC is starting the Missional Church Consultation Initiative (MCCI). This is a church revitalization process through the Minnesota Annual Conference. It is senior pastor intensive, with Pastor Rich reading and attending monthly cohort meetings, and bringing back assignments to BUMC leadership. At the end of this process we will hold an all church meeting to adopt our revitalization strategy. We will also be using this process to explore with North United Methodist some partnership arrangements with them and BUMC to help them revitalize their ministry as well. The first thing you will be hearing will be around prayer, with what MCCI calls a breakthrough prayer. We will be announcing some prayer walks soon and other settings in which we will pray and develop our breakthrough prayer. Please keep the MCCI process, and Pastor Rich in your daily prayers as we venture through this process.


